Important Dates and Times

EXEMPTION POLICY (PARENT-STUDENT HANDBOOK, P. 13)

- A student may exempt the Second Semester exam for any class in which he/she has achieved a cumulative yearly average of 90 or above. A student taking a one-semester course (i.e. health, SAT Prep, etc) may not exempt the exam.
- Students who have missed more than seven class periods during Second Semester **or have missed more than 14 class periods for the entire year** (excluding school-related events) will not be allowed to exempt the exam for the class in question. **No exceptions and no appeals.**

Reminder: All accounts, including tuition, fees, lunchroom, athletic (including equipment), library, pictures, etc. must be settled before students may take semester exams. Parents should ensure their entire account is settled by **Friday, May 11.** **After that time, teachers will receive a list of students who have unsettled accounts.**
