High School Summer Reading Assignment

Please read these instructions carefully to complete the summer reading requirement with the three related assignments. However, you will complete only one of these assignments before school begins. Further instructions regarding the other two assignments will be explained after school begins. Students must have read their book and completed their Dialectical Journal when school begins in August. If you have any questions, please contact Fay Price at fprice@trinitydublin.org

The first assignment is the Dialectical Journal. Complete this journal as you read the book and submit it on the second day of class. It will be the first Daily Grade of Q1. The Dialectical Journal is available as a separate link on the website.

The second assignment is a Major Works Data Sheet. Using your book, this will be completed during class on the designated date. It will be the first Quiz Grade of Q1.

The third assignment is a timed- written assessment that will be completed during class on the designated date. Using a writing prompt, you will analyze a topic to include specific details about the theme, characters, plot, and setting of your book. It will be the first Test Grade of Q1.

Choose a book from the list below for your grade level for the 2023-2024 school year. This must be a book you have not read. Asterisks indicate the books that are more appropriate for the CP level students. Honors students may NOT read books marked with an asterisk. CP students may read any book for their grade level. Students are responsible for obtaining their own copy of the book and must have a paper copy of the book for use in class. Be sure that you have the full or unabridged version of the book. No graphic novels, adapted, or abridged versions are allowed.

Before choosing a book, please read summaries and/or reviews of the book. Select a book YOU believe will interest you. All books are available on Amazon. You must have a paper copy at school to complete in class assignments. Electronic versions of the books will not be allowed in class.
