### Important Dates and Times

- **Wednesday, May 8** Student Recognition Chapel (EL 8:30 a.m., MS/HS 9:00 a.m.) H. Clyde Evans Fieldhouse. Students will be recognized for perfect attendance, class subject awards (MS/HS), and a few other awards.
- **Thursday, May 9** – Upper School Honors Program 6:00 p.m. (H. Clyde Evans Fieldhouse)
- **Friday, May 10** – Middle School/High School review day for exams
- **Monday, May 13-Thursday, May 16** – Middle School and High School students will take their exams at the scheduled times below. Students may be dismissed after completing their last exam for the day, but **they must have a note signed by a parent and students must leave campus. The note must have been given to the teacher before the exam period begins.** Supervision is provided and required for students who must be at school during a time when they don't have an exam.
- **Monday, May 13 at 1:00 & Wednesday, May 15 at 7:00** – Graduation Practice for Seniors, H. Clyde Evans Fieldhouse and Cleve Warnock Field, **Thursday, May 16** is scheduled if necessary, 7:00 p.m.
- **Tuesday, May 14**– Kindergarten Graduation, H. Clyde Evans Fieldhouse, 9:00 a.m.
- **Wednesday, May 15** – Elementary Honors Day 1<sup>st</sup> grade 9:30, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade 10:00, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade 10:30, in classrooms; 4<sup>th</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> grade, 11:15 a.m., H. Clyde Evans Fieldhouse. Lunch will not be served to students- K4-5<sup>th</sup> dismissed at noon.
- **Friday, May 17 –49<sup>th</sup> Annual TCS Commencement Exercises -TCS Class of 2023 Graduation, Cleve Warnock Stadium, 7:30 p.m.**

### Kindergarten and Elementary

Students in K4-5<sup>th</sup> grade will follow their regular schedules through Tuesday, May 14. On Wednesday, May 15 lunch will not be served to students, and K4-5<sup>th</sup> grade will be dismissed at noon.

### Middle School and High School Exam Information

Students may be dismissed after completing their last exam for the day, but they must have a note signed by a parent. Students must leave campus **immediately**. The note must have been given to the teacher before the exam period begins. Supervision is provided and required for students who must be at school during a time when they don't have an exam. Do not email or call the office to request dismissal for your student. The office will not call in to classrooms and emails may not be forwarded.

- *Students cannot sign out of their first exam early, even if they finish before break.*
- *If students do not have a second exam, they can leave at break without a note.*
- *If students ONLY have a second exam, they must still report to their first class at 8:00 a.m. and use it as a study hall.*
- *If students do not have any exams on a day due to electives, they do not have to come to school*
- *Students are allowed to leave when they finish their 7th period exam.*
